Important News: *Organ donation made easier & more effective!*

On July 28th, Florida officials launched an updated on-line donor registry—The Joshua Abbot Organ & Tissue Donor Registry. This technologically upgraded registry allows Floridians to sign up as organ, tissue and eye donors 24/7 from the comfort of their homes @ www.DonateLifeFlorida.org.

► Officials recommend that even if you have "organ donor" on your driver's license, you should sign up on this new registry as well, to ensure your previous

designation is documented. ► Here is why: There have been problems in the past with people that wanted to donate being denied their final wish because their donor card or driver's license were not available or the old computerized donor list was not operating properly, preventing doctors from knowing of the person's wishes.

► In 2008 there were 747 organ and tissue donors in Florida and 1,921 transplant recipients. ► Right now there are 3,646 candidates on the waiting lists for transplants in Florida. ► It is hoped that this updated, more efficient, effective, modern system will help ease the organ donor shortage. **Donate Life, Florida!**



Consumer Protection Accident Guide Book

Commonly Seen Situation: Clever Insurance Adjuster Tactics. Part VI

This series of articles focuses on some of the ways that the Insurance Company's adjuster may try to take advantage of you if you have been injured in an accident.

Beware: You are not on an even playing field with the Insurance Company! Insurance claims adjusters receive extensive training in tactics about how to save their employer, the Insurance Company, money. Remember, they are the professionals in this field, you are not.

► **Tactic #7: The insurance adjuster may act like your friend.** The insurance claims adjuster may befriend you and make it appear that he or she is just looking out for your best interest, when, in fact ,they are not! Sometimes the adjuster will give you advice about the type or frequency of your medical treatment and then be unwilling to pay for all your medical expenses. Sometimes the claims adjuster encourages you to get back to work immediately even though your doctor has advised otherwise.

Meldon's Suggestions: How to avoid being taken advantage of.

► **What to do: Remember that the insurance adjuster is trying to save their company money on your claim.** This creates an immediate conflict of interest. You should always follow your doctor's orders. The insurance adjuster is not your friend. They are trained professionals that have received extensive training in how to save their company money. Many companies reward their adjusters with bonuses or promotions based on how much money the adjuster saves the company.



The Office Blogs: Vehicle vs. Wildlife—reminders for all of us.

Recently, an elderly woman and her son encountered a 130 lb deer on a road outside of Panama City when it jumped out and crashed through the windshield of their car, spreading blood everywhere. Mother and son were lucky and escaped with only minor injuries. Unfortunately for the deer, the impact was fatal. **What can we learn from this encounter of vehicle vs. wildlife?**

1. **Gruesome as it was, this is not an unusual event**, especially in our rural areas where it is common place to see dead animals by the side of the road. In fact, drivers hit an average of 1.5 million deer per year in the U.S.
2. **You never know what is up ahead of you on the road**, so be prepared with both hands on the wheel, eyes on the road, pay attention to the road, and obey the speed limit.
3. **Always buckle-up!** Not only is it the law, but rural roads are some of the most dangerous for many reasons, including wildlife; plus rural drivers are less likely to wear seat belts.
4. **Remember: Deer do not carry insurance!** If you are in a collision with a deer and have only the required Florida insurance, there may be **no money to pay for the damages to your vehicle** and only \$10,000 to cover your medical expenses and lost wages if you are injured. **With this in mind, make sure to have collision and comprehensive ins. for damage to your car and Med. Pay for you and your passenger's injuries.**
5. **These Floridians were lucky. Many are not so fortunate with wildlife encounters.** If this driver had not been paying attention or was speeding, the outcome could have been very different.



Law Talk 101: Traumatic Brain Injury discussed.

Traumatic brain injury (TBI) is a serious medical condition that can cause long term consequences, disabilities, and can be fatal. Motor vehicle accidents are the #1 cause of TBI. Here is the info:

- **In a crash**, or other head trauma, the brain is forced to quickly stop motion, causing it to slam into and then ricochet against the hard skull bone.
- **Basically**, what occurs in the brain after this type of trauma is similar to what happens when you hit your thumb with a hammer.... It bleeds inside and swells up. However, unlike the thumb and other tissues in the body, the skull is not able to expand and swell in response to the build up of blood within, so it presses on the delicate brain tissue, causing damage to the brain itself.
- **Diagnosis of TBI can be difficult.** Many people feel "just fine" after an accident that caused bleeding in the brain (often, it isn't until later when they begin to feel not so well and they can then deteriorate quickly into a coma).
- **For this reason**, it is extremely important to be assessed by a physician immediately after an accident if head trauma is suspected. (A person with TBI often does not think clearly, and will think they are fine.)
- **It is important to note**, even mild TBI (MTBI) can cause long term disabilities.
- **How can the risk of TBI be lowered?** Always wear your seat belt; use child car seats; don't drive under the influence; wear protective head gear on ATVs, bikes, and scooters; and don't drive distracted!

"Remember, TBI is a serious medical condition with potential long term consequences and it should be evaluated ASAP by a medical doctor who may order diagnostic testing such as a CT scan to see if there is any bleeding in the brain."

Interesting Case of the Month: *How DID we do it?*

This month we are posing a question to our readers; see if you can figure out how we did it.

Here is the accident info: As a man and his fiancée (our client) were making a left turn to go home, they were hit by a car (with no insurance) going the other direction. The driver died in his fiancée's arms at the scene; she sustained a permanent injury to her leg.

Here are the facts in the case:

1. The crash report cited the deceased man to be at-fault for not yielding the right of way. The homicide investigator determined that the other driver was at-fault for speeding and passing on a double yellow line and he was charged with vehicular homicide.
2. Our client's fiancée had insurance of \$100,000 of Bodily Injury (BI) (**which pays if you are at fault**) and \$100,000 of Uninsured Motorist Coverage (UM) (**which pays if you are not at-fault and the at-fault driver has no or too little insurance to cover your claim**).

Here are the results of the case: We were able to make a claim for and receive both the UM and the BI coverage for our client from her fiancée's insurance, totaling \$200,000.

The question: How can one insurance policy pay for one accident with coverage (for being at-fault and also not at-fault)?

The answer: By utilizing Florida's doctrine of Comparative Negligence, which applies when more than one person is at fault for an accident. **So, essentially, the deceased driver was at-fault and also not at-fault, so both UM and BI were applicable in this case.**

Disclaimer: Just because we obtained these results in this case, does not necessarily mean we can get them on every case. Each case is unique.

► Here is the information: Safe Kids of North Central Florida, whose mission is to prevent accidental death and injury to children ages 14 and under, frequently holds car seat checks throughout Gainesville and the surrounding areas. ► Parents can bring their children's car seats to the event to have them properly installed and checked by a certified car seat technician. ► Call Safe Kids @ 352 231 4636 or on line @ ShandsSafeKids.org to schedule a car seat check and to find out more information about car seat recommendations and requirements. Checks are free, but appointments are needed. Remember, not only is it safe to properly restrain your child.. It is also the law in Fl.!
