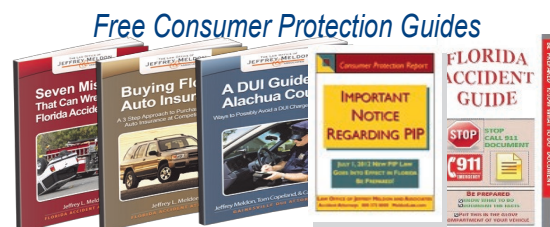

to sue Uber drivers when they cause a crash. **4.** Florida Case law update for 2015-2016. **5.** Airbag litigation based on recent recalls. **6.** What to do when the Insurance Company acts in "Bad Faith." **7.** How to pick a jury that will give your client a fair shake at trial.

Jeffrey and Carey also attended a DUI seminar presented by the Florida Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers on September 16, 2016 in Orlando, FL. Lectures included topics dealing with breath test devices and why they sometimes fail to give accurate information, as well as why field sobriety tests are not always the best way to determine a person's sobriety. 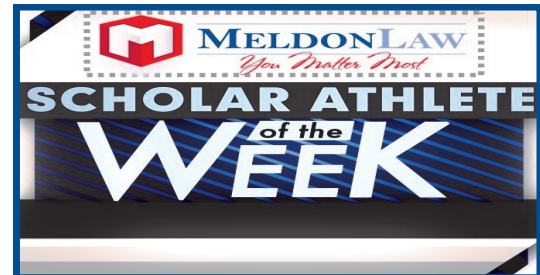
